

Useful Commands

<Ctrl-D>	Terminates a process or command.
alias	Allows you to create pseudonyms for commands.
cal	Displays a calendar on screen.
cat	Allows joining of files
cd	Changes the current working directory.
cp	Copy files.
exit	Ends a shell that you have started.
hostname	Displays the name of the host computer that you are logged on to.
lpr or lp	Prints files
ls	Display names of files and directories in the current working directory.
man	Manual pages for a command or topic.
mkdir	Create a new directory.
more	View the contents of a file one screenful at a time.
mv	Move or rename files.
passwd	Change password on the computer.
pwd	See the name of the current working directory.
rm	Delete a file from the file structure.
rmdir	Delete a directory.
unalias	Undefined pseudonyms for commands.
uname	Displays information about the operating system running the computer.
whatis	Brief description of a command.
whereis	Displays the path(s) for commands.
who	Displays names of users currently on the system.
whoami	Displays your user name.
